## ZELL MILLER SUPPORTS TIM GOLDEN

Washington, D.C. – United States **Senator Zell Miller**, in a mailing to the voters in the 8<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District of Georgia, has issued a strong statement in support of **State Senator Tim Golden's** re-election for another term in the State Senate.

“Tim Golden has always been there when it matters for Georgia families, and that's why he has been a **great State Senator**” Miller said in the mailing, “I just hope his district will allow him to continue his outstanding record of service to south Georgia.”

The mailing cites Golden's support of issues from welfare reform to smaller class sizes, from tax cuts to tough crime laws, from sales tax holidays for working families to pro-business legislation. It concludes with Miller saying, “Senator Golden has a proven record of accomplishment and a vision for the future.”

In making the announcement, Golden said, “Senator Miller encouraged me in 1998 to seek this Senate seat, and with his help that year, I was successful in winning a seat in the State Senate. I am grateful for his help once again this year and pleased to know that he still supports my work in the Georgia Legislature.”

In a radio ad playing this week on stations in South Georgia, Senator Miller praises Senator Golden for authoring numerous bills cutting taxes for Georgia families and businesses, saying at one point, “Tim Golden is responsible for more tax cuts than anyone else in the history of Georgia – even me.”

Senator Golden has been endorsed by the National Rifle Association (NRA); National Federation of Independent Businesses (NFIB); the Medical Association of Georgia; the Georgia Retail Association; and other “stalwarts of conservatism” as described by the Capitol News Bureau at the State Capitol for the AJC.
